

TRI-COUNTY RECREATION PLAYING RULES ADDENDUM

Effective Spring 2020

Summary

The rules outlined below apply solely to regular season games. Unless specified, rules revert to the Tri-County Tournament Rules.

Recreation Season Rules

1. Game Duration

- 1.1. Games will end at the conclusion of the last inning started before the time limit has expired, or when the maximum number of innings for that age group has been played.
 - 1.1.1. If the Home Team is ahead after time has expired, the bottom of the inning will not be played.
- 1.2. If the maximum number of innings have been played for an age group and the game is tied with time remaining on the clock, one additional inning may be played with the following run limits: 5 runs for 6U and 8U; 3 runs for 10U and up. Games can end in a tie.
- 1.3. For all ages, there will be a time limit for each game where no new inning will be started:
 - 1.3.1. 6U, 8U - No new inning after 70 minutes
 - 1.3.2. 10U & Up - No new inning after 80 minutes
