· All teams can play with 11 players since all teams only have 11 players. This eliminates the need for someone to sit the bench each inning

Mill Creek Athletic Association (Bogan Park)

ALL:

- Minor (10U) Pitching all teams will have at least two pitchers that pitch in every game. A complete inning is defined as starting and finishing the same inning. (For instance, the entire third inning). It does not matter what inning the pitcher pitches. If one of the top two pitchers is out for any game, the team will still have to provide two pitchers, each pitching at least one inning. We strongly suggest you develop a third pitcher in case one of your pitchers is not available to play on any given day.
- The second half of season, it actually increases to a minmum of two innings for at least two pitchers for both teams. Second half is based on the teams playing. As long as one team is playing it's 7th or higher game, minimum innings per two pitchers is two. No minimum for third or more pitchers.

*Park rules only when MC is playing another MC team at Bogan Park. For Out-of-park teams playing at Bogan Park, this rule does not apply to either team.

*The intention of this rule is to help the park develop new pitchers for current and future seasons.
